DISCIPLINE COMMITTEE

The Discipline Committee consists of certain teachers which are selected by the College Authority. The current committee consists of:

- Ms. Limasenla Jamir Asst. Professor Department of Sociology
- Ms. A. Ajungla Jamir Asst. Professor Department of English

Students are required to strictly adhere to all the instructions and policies issued by the College Authority:

- 1. Students are required to abide by all the rules and regulations of College. Defaulters will be liable for disciplinary action as decided by the Discipline Committee/College Authority.
- 2. Students must be punctual and regular in attending class. A student whose attendance is less than 80% in any semester may be asked to discontinue their studies in the College.
- 3. College property must be handled with utmost care. In case of any damage, the student is liable to pay for the damage.
- 4. Keep your college and surrounding clean just as you would keep your house clean. No spitting, no littering and no scribbling. Students are to adhere to the cleanliness rules issued by the JMC Students' Council.
- 5. Students are required to behave in a disciplined and dignified manner within and outside the College. Abusive behaviour, physical violence or acts of indiscipline will not be tolerated and appropriate disciplinary action will be taken by the Discipline Committee/College Authority against the student.
- 6. Students must conduct themselves with politeness, respect and regard for faculty members, staff members and with each other.
- 7. The use of tobacco or smoking within the College premises is not allowed. Alcohol, drugs or any other intoxicating substance is strictly prohibited for students. The College has the right to conduct searches/tests for such substances. Any student found to be under the influence of or in possession of such substances is liable to expulsion from the College without prior warning.
- 8. Students are required to adhere to dress code/uniform as prescribed by the College within the premises. Except on Wednesdays and Saturdays, all students should wear black shoes.
- 9. Students should not go outside the College premises or loiter around the College during class hours. Students are also expected not to loiter about in their uniform after College hours.
- 10. Students shall always wear identity cards issued by the College with a tag and show them as and when demanded by the Principal, teachers and office staff.

- 11. Students are to park their cars and bikes at the designated parking area and not anywhere else. Students are also not allowed to blast music from the vehicles during College hours.
- 12. Students are not allowed to form any association/ organization/ union within and outside the College, except those which are specifically created or recognized by the College authority for such purposes.
- 13. Participation or involvement of students in any form of agitation, subversive activities or any demonstration which are prejudicial to the interest of the College is strictly prohibited.
- 14. Without prior written approval of the authority, any kind of celebration, gathering or meeting within the College will not be allowed.
- 15. Students are not allowed to raise any funds from any Student/teacher/staff for any purpose without the written approval of the concerned authority.
- 16. Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited. Any student indulging in or encouraging/abetting such activities, whether actively or passively, will be expelled immediately. Concerned individuals can contact the members of the Anti-Ragging Cell for further assistance.
- 17. In case of any matter not covered here or for interpretation of any content, the decision of the College Authority shall be final and binding on all concerned.
